

NEAFL HITS NEWCASTLE

This Saturday 27 May, Newcastle will play host to a key Round 9 match of the North East Australian Football League (NEAFL) with the Sydney Swans taking on the Gold Coast Suns. The game will kick off at 12pm at Number 1 Sportsground, Parry St Newcastle and entry is free for spectators.

This is one of three regional matches for the NEAFL this season, with Wagga Wagga and Alice Springs the other regional centres hosting games in 2017.

NEAFL Operations Manager Luke Gatti said he is looking forward to heading to Newcastle for the match.
