A record nine players from NSW/ACT selected at the 2016 NAB AFL National Draft

It was a successful night for players from NSW/ACT at Friday's NAB AFL National Draft, with nine players from the region selected overall, the highest number yet. This bettered last year's result of seven players selected and included four in the top twenty for the second year running.

This result follows a record showing of 11 NSW/ACT players invited to the National Draft Combine earlier this year and continues the strong trend of top end talent coming from the region in recent years.
